THE BOOK OF JOSHUA


The Book of Joshua is the sixth book of the Bible and the first book of the History section of the Bible.

Then Joshua spoke to the Lord in the day when the Lord delivered up the Amorites before the children of Israel, and he said: “Sun, stand still over Gibeon; and moon, in the Valley of Aijalon.” So the sun stood still, and the moon stopped, till the people had revenge upon their enemies.

1. Joshua the son of Nun The successor of Moses
2. From the tribe of Ephraim

4. The name Joshua comes from the Hebrew meaning “salvation” or “the Lord saves”
5. He was born in Egypt during the weary years of bondage - He died at the age of 110 years
6. He was appointed by Moses to be the military leader during the first battle against the Amalakites after they came out of Egypt- (Exodus 17:8-15)
7. Joshua along with eleven others was chosen to search the Land of Canaan representing his tribe. Along with Caleb, they brought a faithful report about the Promised Land and trusted that God would fulfill His promise. Therefore, they were the only two from the Israelites who were born in Egypt to enter the Promised Land
8. Achievements:
 - He led the people to the Promised Land crossing the Jordan River- He divided the lands among the tribes of Israel

But as for me and my house, we will serve the LORD.” Joshua 24: 15

Did you know?

In the book of Joshua we see Joshua, the leader, bringing God's people into the Promised Land. In the New Testament we see another leader who came to take God's people into the promised land - eternal life in heaven. This is Jesus of course.




