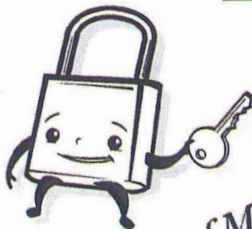
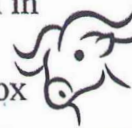
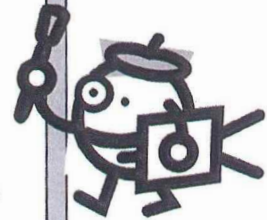


Who is St. Luke?



He wrote the Gospel according to St. Luke and the Book of Acts

- ❖ He was the only gentile converted author in the New Testament
- ❖ He was a physician and a skilled painter; he painted the icon of St. Mary
- ❖ He was St. Paul's companion in many of his missionary trips
- ❖ He addressed his book to Theophilus (the lover of God) also it was written to the Greek to find the perfect man in Christ
- ❖ The symbol of St. Luke is the ox
