

❖ The Bible is a collection of books written by different people during more than 1000 years.


❖ It is divided into Old Testament and New Testament

- The first 5 books, written by Moses (Genesis, Exodus, Leviticus, Numbers and Deuteronomy) are also called Torah or the “Five Books of Moses”.

## THE NEW TESTAMENT

- 27 Books
- 4 Gospels (St. Matthew, St. Mark, St. Luke and St. John)
- The Book of Acts
- The Epistles or letters (Written by St. Paul (14), St. James (1), St. Peter (2), (1) St. John (3), and St. Jude (1))
- The Book of Revelation



On **day one** God created the light.




*God said, "Let there be light" Gen 1:3*





# THE GARDEN OF EDEN

Genesis 2-3




- In the East of Eden, God made a garden in which grew every tree and plant
- In the middle of it He put 2 important trees, the “tree of life” and the “tree of knowledge”.
- God told Adam to eat from all the trees EXCEPT the tree of knowledge.

- God brought all the animals to Adam so he might name them.

▪ The serpent tempted Eve, she ate from the fruit of the tree of knowledge, and she gave from it to Adam and he ate too!

- They sewed fig leaves to cover themselves, and hid themselves so God would not see them.



- God cursed the serpent, and banished it from the Garden.
- He gave clothes to Adam and Eve, and kicked them out of the Garden, into the world.
- He placed cherubim at the east of the garden of Eden, and a flaming sword which turned every way, to guard the way to the tree of life.



# NOAH'S ARK

Genesis 6-7

↳ As the years passed, the descendants of Adam grew in number and spread all over the earth.

↳ They were very wicked; and God decided to destroy all people and animals that had been created.

↳ However, there was one man who led a good and honest life, and whom God loved.

**THIS MAN WAS NOAH.**

↳ God chose to save Noah, his wife and his 3 children, (Shem, Ham and Japheth), and their wives.

↳ God asked Noah to build an ark to protect him and his family from the rain.

↳ God asked Noah to take with him in the ark: his family, 7 of each clean animals, 2 of each unclean animals (male and female), and enough food for all.



*God told Noah that He will send rain for 40 days and 40 nights.*



Noah did exactly as God had told him. When the ark was ready Noah and his family led the animals in the ark, then they themselves went inside and God shut them in.



- After seven days, Noah sent the dove again but this time she came back in the evening with a branch of olive leaves in her beak.
- After another seven days Noah sent the dove one more time, this time she did not return.
- Noah looked and saw that the ground was dry.




# THE TOWER OF BABEL

**The Lord confused their language**




Everyone found that the words spoken by one person meant nothing for their neighbour. This caused confusion.
